
Let's find out the key needs to move forward on digitalization in the Swiss AgroFood sector and define concrete opportunities for collaboration.

Location Details

The workshop will take place in the Siemens Auditorium (HIT E51) of the ETH Zurich Hönggerberg, Wolfgang-Pauli-Strasse 27, 8000 Zurich.

How to Reach ETH Hönggerberg from Zurich Central Station (approx. 25 minutes)

- Take the S-Bahn (Lines 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 14, 16) to Oerlikon station. From Oerlikon Nord station take bus no. 80 (towards Triemlispital) as far as the "ETH Hönggerberg" stop
- Take Tram no. 11 (towards Auzelg) as far as "Bucheggplatz". From there, take bus no. 69 (towards ETH Hönggerberg) as far as the terminus "ETH Hönggerberg"
- Take Tram no. 14 (towards Seebach) as far as "Milchbuck". From there, take bus no.
 69 (towards ETH Hönggerberg) as far as the terminus "ETH Hönggerberg"
