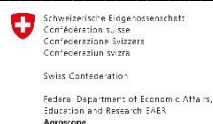

Gala dinner on June 26

The Gala dinner will be held in the house of "[ZunftHaus zur Schmiden](#)" (blacksmith brotherhood), an amazing location in the heart of Zurich's Old Town.

A building steeped in history, where tradition and modernity merge perfectly.

Smith's Guild

Its origin lies in the merging of various tradesmen groups: smiths, sword smiths (weapons), pewterers (dishes/platters), bell makers (cow bells, church bells), tinsmiths, helmet makers, shearers and barbers.



The guild tradition is maintained in Zurich like in no other city. The annual "Sechseläuten" is the high point. During this popular springtime festival, the Zurich guilds march to the Sechseläutenplatz, where at 18.00 the "Böögg" (resembles a snowman) is burnt. In the evening, the various guilds visit one another in their respective guild houses.

Mountain excursion on June 27

The [Stanserhorn](#) is a mountain located in the canton of Nidwalden with the peak at 1,898 metres above sea level. It is a popular tourist destination, which can be reached from the adjacent town of [Stans](#) by a funicular railway and cable car.

We'll start from Zurich at 13:30 and join the funicular railway station by bus. After an amazing ascent to the top of the mountain by funicular and a short walk around the top, we'll be back to the city of Zurich for sharing lunch together at 20.00 pm.



Abstract submissions

Attendees are invited to offer papers and the International Scientific Committee will decide for an oral or a poster presentation. The papers presented at the Symposium will be peer-reviewed and published in *Acta Horticulturae*. The abstracts have to be submitted in English and electronically through ISHS System ROSA - before the 26th of November 2018 (LAST deadline !)

Please login to ISHS before the submission. If you're non-member, please become member before submitting. The presenting author must register in full for the Symposium no later than 28th of February 2019 or the abstract will be withdrawn from the program. **The limit is set to 300 words and cannot be exceeded.**

Paper submission

Once the abstract has been accepted for oral or poster presentation, authors are expected to submit their papers in English, following [the ISHS Authors Guidelines](#). Papers will be published by the ISHS in *Acta Horticulturae* as proceedings of the Symposium.

Papers must be submitted electronically through [ISHS ROSA System](#) before **15th of March 2019**. A manual for online paper submission is available on the link mentioned above.

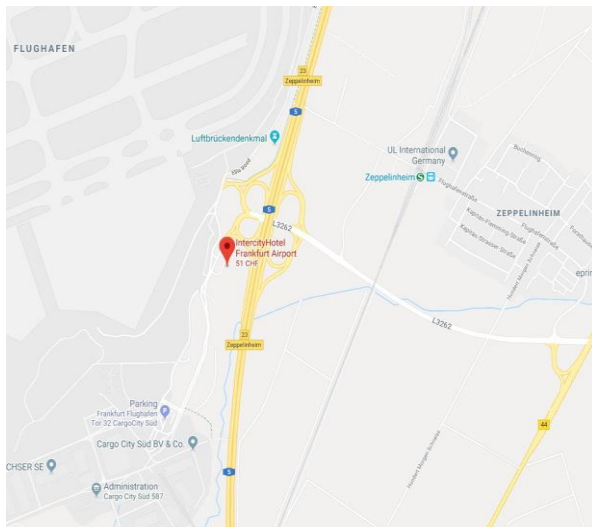
